Birding

 Drotsky's is situated on the Okavango River, in the pan-handle of the Delta. The area is renowned for sightings of birding specials such as Pel's Fishing Owl, Nerina Trogan and African Skimmer, while keen birders can also be on the look-out for brown firefinch, swamp bou-bou's and long-toed lapwings.

• Boat trips on the Okavango River

 Explore the Okavango by boat and enjoy the tranquillity of the river while searching for the elusive sitatunga hiding in the reeds

Fishing

- Enjoy an afternoon of fishing in the Okavango River that is abundant with fish species such as bream, tiger- and barbel (cat-fish).
- Fishing season is from 1 March to 31 December each year. In order to ensure a healthy ecology in the river, no fishing is allowed during January and February

Self-drive Activities from Drotsky's

Tsodilo Hills

 Tsodilo Hills is a UNESCO World Heritage Site only 65km from Drotsky's, consisting of 4 hills named the "Male", "Female", "Child" and a smaller unnamed hill. Here one can view rock art and rock shelters thousands of years old.

Mahangu National Park

- This beatiful reserve is situated along the Okavango River, in the Caprivi Strip of Namibia. It borders on Botswana and is accessed through the Mohembo border post, just 14km from Drotsky's.
- The park has a wide variety of wildlife, including roan and sable antelope, elephant, buffalo and red lechwe.

Popa Falls

 Just outside the gate to Mahango National Park, 55km from Drotsky's, is Popa Falls, a series of fast flowing rapids that can be assessed on foot from the rest camp area.
